Psalm 46:7 (NASB)

The LORD of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our stronghold. Selah.

Isaiah 37:16 (NIV)

¹⁶ "LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, enthroned between the cherubim, You alone are God over all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth."

- The Lord dwells upon the mercy seat.
- This is also known as the throne of grace.



Hebrews 4:16 (NASB)

¹⁶ Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

He is Lord of the **Cosmic Hosts**

Genesis 2:1 (NKJV)

And the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them.

Isaiah 40:26 (NIV)

Lift your eyes and look to the heavens: Who created all these? He who brings out the starry host one by one, and calls them each by name. Because of His great power and mighty strength, not one of them is missing.

He is Lord of the **Angelic Hosts**

1 Kings 22:19 (NIV)

Micaiah continued, "Therefore hear the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on His throne with all the host of heaven standing around Him on His right and on His left."

Psalm 103:21 (NIV)

Praise the LORD, all His heavenly hosts, you His servants who do His will.

Exodus 6:26 (NASB)

²⁶ It was *the same* Aaron and Moses to whom the LORD said, "Bring out the sons of Israel from the land of Egypt according to their hosts."

Exodus 7:4 (NASB)

⁴ "When Pharaoh does not listen to you, then I will lay My hand on Egypt and bring out My hosts, My people the sons of Israel, from the land of Egypt by great judgments."

Isaiah 9:7 (NASB)
