ESTHER 2:3

³ and let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather all the beautiful young virgins to Shushan the citadel, into the women's quarters, under the custody of Hegai the king's eunuch, custodian of the women. And let beauty preparations be given them.

ESTHER 2:8-9

⁸ So it was, when the king's command and decree were heard, and when many young women were gathered at Shushan the citadel, under the custody of Hegai, that Esther also was taken to the king's palace, into the care of Hegai the custodian of the women. 9 Now the young woman pleased him, and she obtained his favor; so he readily gave beauty preparations to her, besides her allowance...

ESTHER 2:12

¹² Each young woman's turn came to go in to King Ahasuerus after she had completed twelve months' preparation, according to the regulations for the women, for thus were the days of their preparation apportioned: six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with perfumes and preparations for beautifying women.

ESTHER 2:13

ESTHER 2:3, 9, 12-13 (NKJV)

- ³ And let beauty preparations be given them.
- Now the young woman pleased him, and she obtained his favor; so he readily gave beauty preparations to her, besides her allowance.

ESTHER 2:3, 9, 12-13 (KJV)

³ and let their things for purification be given them ⁹ And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, which were meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best place of the house of the women. 12 Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of the women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with sweet odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women).

Strong's Concordance

- 1. 8562: **tamruq** a scraping, rubbing, cleanse, thing for purification
- 2. 4838: maraq to scour, polish, sharpen, rinse
- 3. 4795: **maruq** a scraping, rubbing, properly, purification

"scour" defined as

"to remove dirt from something by rubbing it hard with something rough"

"the act of removing harmful substances
