




- Not BUILDING but COMMUNITY

(Zec 8:4-5; Joel 2:27-29)




- ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called;



1 Sam 3, 1 Kings 12, Joseph, David, Daniel


III. BRIDGE THE GENERATIONS
